2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §9097, sub-§2-B** is enacted to read:

6 **2-B. Notice to tenant of rented or leased mobile home.** The
8 owner of a mobile home may terminate the tenancy for any of the
10 reasons in subsection 1. The notice provisions must be those
12 specified in the lease. If there is no lease for the mobile
14 home, the notice is governed by Title 14, section 6002.

SUMMARY

14 This bill provides the same termination notice period for
rented mobile homes as for other residential buildings.
