2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §54 is enacted to read:
4	§54. State compliance with laws and regulations applied

8	All state departments, agencies and boards are required to comply with any law, rule or regulation for which compliance by
10	the public or private industry is demanded. Compliance pertains to all state laws, rules and regulations and all municipal
12	ordinances and regulations.
14	Sec. 2. Liberal interpretation. The provisions of this Act are to be liberally construed.
16 18	Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2000.

22	This bill requires State Government to comply with all state and local laws for which compliance by the public and private
