COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1246, L.D. 1775, "Resolve, to Develop a Disaster Relief Food Assistance Program"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 6th line (page 1, line 32 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "3 months" and inserting in its place the following: 'one month'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

## APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$18,000,000

This resolve includes a General Fund appropriation of \$18,000,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 for the Maine Emergency Management Agency within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management to establish a disaster relief food assistance program.'

## SUMMARY

This amendment changes the original resolve by decreasing the number of months worth of food storage required from 3 months to one month. It also reduces the appropriation to carry out the purposes of this resolve from \$50,000,000 to \$18,000,000. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
