48	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It differs from the majority report because it allows fees to be
50	charged against mortuary trusts for the administration of the

- mortuary trust account. The bill limits the fees to be charged to only those fees for the actual financial and tax administration of the trust account. Like the majority report, the amendment qualifies the type of insurance that may be purchased with money in a mortuary trust account and replaces board members with a designee of the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation on the list of persons authorized to inspect prearranged funeral account records.
- The amendment also adds an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
