COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 633, L.D. 1800, Bill, "An Act Concerning Standards for Operation and Maintenance of Radio Antenna Towers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§3012." in the first paragraph in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 9 to 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the Amateur Radio Preemption, 101 FCC 2d 952 (1985), as issued by the Federal Communications Commission, which" and inserting in its place the following: 'a Federal Communications Commission regulation that'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill may decrease the number of violations of municipal ordinances filed in the court system. The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed.'
