
SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 638, L.D. 1805, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Prompt Payment of Unemployment Compensation Benefits to Displaced Workers"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1-A in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "employees on" and inserting in its place the following: 'employees no later than'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that partial unemployment claim forms for a week must be provided to eligible employees no later than the day that the payroll for that week is available to employees.
