Resolve, to Direct the State to Implement a Simplified Tax and Wage Reporting System with the Federal Government.

Sec. 1. Bureau of Revenue Services to implement simplified tax and 2 wage reporting system with Federal Government. Resolved: That the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services, within existing resources, shall implement the Δ recommendations of the Task Force on State and Federal Tax Filing, established pursuant to Resolve 1997, chapter 66 and 6 cooperate with the Federal Government to develop a single point for filing and paying state and federal employment taxes, sales 8 and use taxes and unemployment contributions. The bureau shall 10 implement the system as soon as practical.

## **SUMMARY**

This resolve requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services to implement the 16 recommendations of the Task Force on State and Federal Tax 18 Filing, established pursuant to Resolve 1997, chapter 66, by developing a single point for filing and paying state and federal 20 employment taxes, sales and use taxes and unemployment contributions. 22
