

2           **Sec. 1. Bureau of Revenue Services to implement simplified tax and**  
3           **wage reporting system with Federal Government. Resolved:** That the  
4           Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of  
5           Revenue Services, within existing resources, shall implement the  
6           recommendations of the Task Force on State and Federal Tax  
7           Filing, established pursuant to Resolve 1997, chapter 66 and  
8           cooperate with the Federal Government to develop a single point  
9           for filing and paying state and federal employment taxes, sales  
10          and use taxes and unemployment contributions. The bureau shall  
11          implement the system as soon as practical.
