SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1258, L.D. 1812, Bill, "An Act to Require the Development of a Basic Needs Budget"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of the last line (page 2, line 8 in amendment)


Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment eliminates the General Fund appropriation of \$2,500 in fiscal year 1999-00 to the State Planning Office. The ability of the State Planning Office to absorb the additional costs associated with adding additional questions to a survey conducted for the Department of Education can not be determined at this time.
