The amounts appropriated are based on the continuation of this Department of Education survey in fiscal year 1999-00. The Legislature is currently considering several proposals that affect the school funding distribution formula and that may eliminate the need for this survey. If the survey is not conducted for the Department of Education, a new survey will need to be developed and funded by the State Planning Office. The amount of the additional appropriations required can not be determined at this time.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment turns the original legislative document into a resolve. It directs the Executive Department, State Planning Office to develop a basic needs budget in cooperation with the Department of Human Services. The amendment also adds an appropriation and a fiscal note.

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
