## **'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill establishes a smoking cessation program to be 4 funded with all funds appropriated or allocated to the Tobacco Prevention and Control Program over the amount of \$3,500,000. 6 This bill establishes legislative intent to designate a portion of the funds available from the national tobacco settlement to 8 fund the smoking cessation program in accordance with the funding formula developed by the federal Department of Health and Human 10 Services, Centers for Disease Control.

12 Additional General Fund appropriations or Other Special Revenue allocations will be needed to provide funding or spending 14 authorizations for this new program according to the formula developed by the Centers for Disease Control and to provide 16 staffing and related operating costs. The amounts that will be required can not be determined at this time and will be dependent 18 on the amounts available from the national tobacco settlement.

 The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to report to the Legislature on its progress in establishing this new smoking cessation program. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment changes the responsibilities of the 30 Department of Human Services from developing, implementing and smoking cessation program to ensuring maintaining a the development, implementation and maintenance of such a program. 32 It deletes the wording on the funding of the smoking cessation 34 program and adds funding in the amount over \$3,500,000 per year appropriated or allocated to the Tobacco Prevention and Control Program. It states the intention of the Legislature to use a 36 funding obtained through the national tobacco portion of settlement to fund the smoking cessation program. 38 It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
