
16 **FISCAL NOTE**

18 This amendment reduces the General Fund costs of the resolve
20 by \$880 in fiscal year 1999-00 from the elimination of the
payment of per diem to public members of the commission.

22 As amended, this resolve includes an additional General Fund
24 appropriation to the Legislature in the amount of \$3,820 in
26 fiscal year 1999-00 for the per diem and expenses of legislative
members and the expenses of other eligible members for 4 meetings
of the Commission to Study Children in Need of Services and to
print the required report.
