Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§6, as amended by PL 1993, c. 419, §3, is further amended to read:

Armed Forces domiciled in Maine. A combination fishing and hunting license must be issued upon-payment-of-\$15-for-1993 and-\$20-for-1994-and-every-year-thereafter,-plus-the-issuing-fee, to a member of the Armed Forces of the United States on active duty whe-is-permanently-stationed-outside-of-the-State,-and-te that-person's-spouse-and-shildren, if that person can show proof that that person's home of record, as recorded in his that person's service records, is Maine. That person must be issued all other licenses or permits at resident fees. The license is valid during the year of issue. A combination fishing and hunting license must be issued upon payment of \$15, plus the issuing fee, to the spouse and children of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States on active duty, if that member can show proof that the member's home of record, as recorded in the member's service records, is Maine.
