Sec. 8. Transition provision. Members of the Sea Urchin Zone Council who were appointed under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6749-X prior to the effective date of this Act and whose membership is affected by this Act shall continue to serve on the council until their current terms expire.

## **SUMMARY** 12

14 This bill makes the following changes to the laws regarding the sea urchin fishery:

- It eliminates the personnel restriction regarding the use of the sea urchin research fund;
- 20 It provides that failure to report required data may result in ineligibility to renew licenses;

- It adds possession of sea urchins on a boat during a closed day as an unauthorized activity;
- It directs the Commissioner of Marine Resources to 26 suspend the sea urchin license of a license holder upon conviction of violating the sea urchin fishing season; 28
- 30 It directs the Commissioner of Marine Resources to suspend a sea urchin license upon conviction of violating the zone harvesting laws; 32
- 34 It places conditions on changing zones so that the number of license holders changing from Zone 1 to Zone 2 equals 36 the number of license holders changing from Zone 2 to Zone 1;
- 38 7. It changes the membership of the Sea Urchin Zone Council from a processor in Zone 1 and a processor from Zone 2 to 2 individuals in Zone 1 who have either a processor's or buyer's 40 permit and 2 individuals in Zone 2 who have either a processor's 42 or buyer's permit; and
- 44 It specifies that the zone council may seek advice from knowledgeable scientists with regard to research needs.
