
SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1287, L.D. 1848, Bill, "An Act to Require the Display of the Prisoner of War - Missing in Action Flag"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**§135**" and inserting in its place the following: '**§136**'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "**§135.**" in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**§135.**" and inserting in its place the following: '**§136.**'

SUMMARY

This amendment is being presented on behalf of the Committee on Bills in the Second Reading to avoid a conflict with Public Law 1999, chapter 19, which enacted a substantively different provision using an identical statute section number.
