Of the total, 28 \$200,000 each year is provided for the Maine Extension 30 Partnership to replace declining federal funds and \$50,000 in each year will support the Francophone Office. 32 No funding for these programs is currently included in the 34 Governor's proposed "Part 2" budget.' 36 **SUMMARY** 38 This amendment is the minority report. The amendment eliminates several appropriations that were included in the 40 original bill. It continues to appropriate funds for the Maine Extension Partnership and clarifies that those funds 42 are ongoing. It also continues funding for the Francophone Office on 44 a one-time basis. Finally, the amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
