HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 665, L.D. 1887, Bill, "An Act to Provide Access to Information Services in All Communities of the State"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§354.~~" in subsection 2 in the 7th line (page 1, line 41 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "one public member" and inserting in its place the following: 'the public member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§354.~~" in subsection 2 in the 9th line (page 1, line 43 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "one public member" and inserting in its place the following: 'the public member appointed by the President of the Senate'

This amendment clarifies the appointing authority for the initial public members of the Maine Governmental Information Network Board.
