	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

	This bill proposes to establish enterprise zones in areas of
10	the State in which the unemployment rate exceeds the statewide
	average unemployment rate by 75% or more. These enterprise zones
12	would receive priority for all state economic development funds.
14	This bill also would establish a fund in the Finance
	Authority of Maine and finance the fund through bonds issued by
16	FAME. A business located in an enterprise zone could receive
	loans from the fund, based on criteria established and
18	administered by FAME.
