20	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "7" to H.P. 1314, L.D. 1897, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Maximum Benefit Levels Provided for Injured Workers"

24	Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§211." in the 4th line from the end (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>January</u> " and inserting in its place
26	the following: 'July'
28	Further amend the bill in the 3rd line from the end (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>the higher of</u>
30	<u>\$600 or 166% of</u> "
32	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
34	'FISCAL NOTE
36	
38	This bill will increase the costs of the State's workers' compensation program. The amount of the increase can not be determined at this time. It will depend on the number of injured
40	state employees eligible for the maximum benefit. Based on past experience and the 1997 state average weekly wage of \$471.27, the
42	estimated cost will be approximately \$19,150 annually beginning in fiscal year 2000-01. An average annual increase of this size
44	will not appreciably affect workers' compensation assessments on state departments and agencies.'
46	SUMMARY
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50	This amendment changes the maximum benefit level to the state average weekly wage beginning July 1, 2000. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
