22	Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 2 and
24	inserting in its place the following:
26	' Sec. 2. Plan. Resolved: That the Director of the Maine State Museum, in consultation with the Penobscot Nation, the
28	Passamaquoddy Tribe, the Houlton Band of Maliseets and the Aroostook Band of Micmacs, shall present to the State House and
30	Capitol Park Commission by December 31, 1999 a plan for including portraits of outstanding Indians for display in the State House.
32	The plan must include funding proposals for commissioning or acquiring the portraits. The Director of the Maine State Museum
34	will forward a copy of the plan to the members of the Joint Standing Committee of the Legislature on State and Local
36	Government.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1315, L.D. 1898

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SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Director of the Maine State Museum by December 31, 1999 to present to the State House and Capitol Park Commission a plan to include outstanding Maine Indians in the collection of State House portraits. It also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
