24	'Sec. 5. Study commission established. The Commission to Study the Most Effective Method of Providing Retail Rate Reimbursement for Parts and Labor, referred to in this section as the
26	"commission," is established to study the most effective method of providing retail rate reimbursement under the Maine Revised
28	Statutes, Title 10, section 1176 while protecting the interests of warranty and nonwarranty repair customers, the ability of
30	franchisees to effectively receive reimbursement at retail rates and the interests of franchisors in relation to making such
32	retail parts and labor reimbursement.
34	1. Membership. The commission consists of 5 members appointed as follows:
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38	A. One member of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate;
40	B. One member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
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	C. Two new motor vehicle dealer franchisees who are members
44	of the Maine Auto Dealers Association, at least one of whom must be from a dealership within 50 miles of the border of
46	New Hampshire, appointed by the Governor; and

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D. One franchisor who is a member of the Alliance of Automobile Manufacturers, appointed by the Governor.

Appointments; chairs; convening. 2. The appointments of members of the commission must be made no later than 30 days 6 following the effective date of this Act. The appointing 8 authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council upon making their appointments. The Senate 10 member is the Senate chair and the House member is the House Within 15 days after appointment of all members, the chair. chairs of the commission shall call and convene the first meeting 12 of the commission.

3. Duties. The commission shall study the Maine Revised
Statutes, Title 10, section 1176 to determine the best manner in which to implement the retail reimbursement provisions for parts
and labor for warranty work while protecting the interests of warranty and nonwarranty repair consumers, the interests of
franchisees in receiving retail rate reimbursements and the question of cost recovery by franchisors.

The commission shall submit a report of its 4. Report. 24 findings and recommendations and accompanying legislation to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business and economic development matters no later than 26 December 15, 2000. The joint standing committee of the 28 Legislature having jurisdiction over business and economic development matters may report out a bill based upon the report. 30 If the commission requires a limited extension of time to make its report it may apply to the Legislative Council which may 32 grant the extension.

34 **5. Staff assistance.** The commission may request staffing assistance from the Legislative Council.

 6. Compensation. The legislative members are entitled to
38 receive the legislative per diem and reimbursement for necessary expenses for their attendance at authorized meetings of the
40 commission.

7. Commission budget. The chairs of the commission, with assistance from the commission staff, shall administer the commission budget. Within 10 days after its first meeting, the commission shall present a work plan and proposed budget to the Legislative Council for its approval. The commission may not incur expenses that would result in the commission's exceeding its approved budget. Upon request from the commission, the Executive Director of the Legislative Council or the executive

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 681, L.D. 1931

The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the commission during the interim between legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes section 3 of Committee Amendment "A" 10 and establishes the Commission to Study the Most Effective Method of Providing Retail Rate Reimbursement for Parts and Labor to 12 study how to most effectively implement the retail rate reimbursement provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, 14 section 1176 while protecting the interests of consumers of warranty and nonwarranty repair services, the interests of 16 franchisees in receiving retail rate reimbursement and the interests of franchisors. The commission comprises a member of 18 the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate; a member of the House, appointed by the Speaker of the House; 2 franchised 20 automobile dealers who are members of the Maine Auto Dealers Association; and one franchisor who is a member of the Alliance 22 of Automobile Manufacturers.
