2. Appointments; chairs; convening.

10 members of the commission must be made n

members of the commission must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this Act. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council upon making their appointments. The Senate member is the Senate chair and the House member is the House chair. Within 15 days after appointment of all members, the chairs of the commission shall call and convene the first meeting of the commission.

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3. Duties. The commission shall study the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 1176 to determine the best manner in which to implement the retail reimbursement provisions for parts and labor for warranty work while protecting the interests of warranty and nonwarranty repair consumers, the interests of franchisees in receiving retail rate reimbursements and the question of cost recovery by franchisors.

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- 4. Report. The commission shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations and accompanying legislation to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business and economic development matters no later than December 15, 2000. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business and economic development matters may report out a bill based upon the report. If the commission requires a limited extension of time to make its report it may apply to the Legislative Council which may grant the extension.
- 5. Staff assistance. The commission may request staffing assistance from the Legislative Council.

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- 6. Compensation. The legislative members are entitled to receive the legislative per diem and reimbursement for necessary expenses for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission.
- 7. Commission budget. The chairs of the commission, with assistance from the commission staff, shall administer the commission budget. Within 10 days after its first meeting, the commission shall present a work plan and proposed budget to the Legislative Council for its approval. The commission may not
