2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §4013, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 5. **Employ director.** The commission may employ a director
8 to serve as the principal administrative and executive employee
10 of the commission. The director may hire staff to carry out the
12 coordination of the affairs of the commission. The director may
14 obtain meeting space, goods and services as required to carry out
16 these responsibilities.

18 **Sec. 2. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
20 from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
