FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will increase the number of persons eligible for the veterans property tax exemption that will require reimbursement beginning in fiscal year 2000-01. Based on the very small number of additional persons eligible, the additional reimbursements to the municipalities for 50% of the property tax revenue lost as a result of the new property tax exemptions can be absorbed within the existing amounts appropriated to the Veterans Tax Reimbursment program.'
