SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 693, L.D. 1939, Bill, "An Act to Fund a Minimum Level of Services for Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing Persons in all Regions of the State"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 1 by striking out all of the 6th line (page 1, line 38 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other	\$100,000	\$100,000'

**FISCAL NOTE**

The amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$100,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01.
