Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5112-A.~~" by striking out all of subsection 3.

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5112-A.~~" by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5112-A.~~" in subsection 4 in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 2, line 14 in amendment) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting in its place the following: '4'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5112-A.~~" in subsection 4 in paragraph B in subparagraph (2) in the first line (page 2, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting in its place the following: '4'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5112-A.~~" in subsection 4 in paragraph C in subparagraph (2) in the first line (page 2, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "5" and inserting in its place the following: '4'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5112-A.~~" in subsection 5 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "4" and inserting in its place the following: '3'

to carry out its objectives. The council is authorized to employ
6 consultants and contract for projects that it considers
necessary" and inserting in its place the following: 'an intern
8 or other qualified person from the Muskie School of Public
Service to provide general staffing assistance, research and
10 policy analysis as directed by the council'

12 Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and
inserting in its place the following:

from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

10 **FISCAL NOTE**


12 This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by
14 \$105,853 in fiscal year 2000-01.

16 As amended, this bill includes General Fund appropriations
18 totaling \$31,260 in fiscal year 2000-01. A General Fund
20 appropriation of \$30,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 is included for
22 the University of Maine System for the costs associated with an
intern or other qualified person from the Muskie School of Public
Service and related operational costs to provide general staffing
assistance and research and policy analysis to the Maine Council
on Aging.

24 **SUMMARY**

26 This amendment removes the position of Executive Director of
28 the Maine Council on Aging and instead provides for an intern
30 from the Muskie School of Public Service who will provide general
staffing assistance, research and policy analysis to the council.

32 This amendment also corrects internal cross-references.
