COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 702, L.D. 1977, Bill, "An Act to Create the Farmington Falls Standard Water District"

Amend the bill in section 6 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**District**" and inserting in its place the following: '**Company**'

Further amend the bill in section 6 in the 14th line (page 2, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "District" and inserting in its place the following: 'Company'

Further amend the bill in section 6 in the last line of the first paragraph (page 2, line 43 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "District" and inserting in its place the following: 'Company'

Further amend the bill in section 8 in that part relating to "Question B" in the last line (page 3, line 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "District" and inserting in its place the following: 'Company'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs associated with the oversight and regulation of one additional water district can be absorbed by the Public Utilities Commission utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes technical corrections to the bill. This bill allows the Farmington Falls Standard Water District, if approved, to take the property and franchise of the Farmington Falls Water Company. The bill also repeals the Farmington Fall Water District, which was created by Private and Special Law 1981, chapter 86, but was never approved by referendum. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
