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Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph after the title (page 1, line 23 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

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'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

26 'Sec. 6. Territory of Sly Brook. The territory of Sly Brook consists of all that land in the Town of Eagle Lake that lies east of the center of the body of water known as Eagle Lake. 28

Sec. 7. Allocation of debts and assets. Sly Brook shall assume 30 debts and assets of the Town of Eagle Lake as follows:

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No assets of the Town of Eagle Lake are due Sly Brook. The municipal building and fire truck that are located in Sly Brook will become the property of Aroostook County.

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Sly Brook shall pay a proportionate ratio based on property valuation of the following debts of the Town of Eagle Lake:

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A. Municipal building;

26	This amendment eliminates the contingent effective date and the referendum requirement. The elimination of the referendum requirement will reduce the costs associated with the state
28	mandate. The deorganization will become effective July 1, 2000 and the costs will be incurred upon the effective date. The
30	General Fund appropriation and revenue impact will not be contingent upon approval of the voters of Sly Brook.
