HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1379, L.D. 1986, Bill, "An Act to Authorize Sly Brook to Secede from Eagle Lake and to Deorganize"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first indented paragraph after the title (page 1, line 23 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 6. Territory of Sly Brook. The territory of Sly Brook consists of all that land in the Town of Eagle Lake that lies east of the center of the body of water known as Eagle Lake.

Sec. 7. Allocation of debts and assets. Sly Brook shall assume debts and assets of the Town of Eagle Lake as follows:

1. No assets of the Town of Eagle Lake are due Sly Brook. The municipal building and fire truck that are located in Sly Brook will become the property of Aroostook County.

2. Sly Brook shall pay a proportionate ratio based on property valuation of the following debts of the Town of Eagle Lake:

- A. Municipal building;
- B. Industrial park;

2 C. Fire truck; and

4 D. Street bond.

6 3. Sly Brook shall bear its just and due proportion of any
8 debt of Maine School Administrative District No. 27.' '

10 Further amend the amendment in section 6 in the 9th to 14th
12 lines (page 1, lines 38 to 43 in amendment) by striking out all
of the last sentence.

14 Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 7
and inserting in its place the following:

16 'Sec. 7. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2000.'

18 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any
20 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
consecutively.

22 FISCAL NOTE

24 This amendment eliminates the contingent effective date and
26 the referendum requirement. The elimination of the referendum
28 requirement will reduce the costs associated with the state
mandate. The deorganization will become effective July 1, 2000
30 and the costs will be incurred upon the effective date. The
General Fund appropriation and revenue impact will not be
32 contingent upon approval of the voters of Sly Brook.

34 SUMMARY

36 This amendment removes the requirement that this matter go
38 to referendum. The amendment adds a description of the territory
of Sly Brook and also clarifies which debts of the Town of Eagle
40 Lake and Maine School Administrative District No. 27 are the
responsibility of Sly Brook. It also adds a fiscal note.
