This resolve includes an additional General Fund appropriation of \$3,890 in fiscal year 1999-00 for the Legislature for the per diem and expenses of legislative members and the expenses of other eligible members of the Committee to Establish a Memorial Dedicated to the Civilian Conservation Corps and to print the required report.

The Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to provide staffing and to participate as a member of the committee. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'
