## FISCAL NOTE

Any net impact on the Judicial Department and the correctional system as a result of the definition of the criminal conduct committed when a person grows or cultivates marijuana will be insignificant.'

## 12 SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that only the cultivation of marijuana is excepted from the crime of trafficking. The amendment also specifies that a person who grows or cultivates 5 or fewer plants is guilty of a Class E crime. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
