SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1409, L.D. 2014, Bill, "An Act to Institutionalize Substance Abuse Treatment Courts in Maine"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
