28 This amendment clarifies that, following the receipt of the commission's report, the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice may report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 119th Legislature. The amendment also strikes language that entitles members other than Legislators to a per diem equal to the legislative per diem.
