
12 **FISCAL NOTE**

14 This amendment reduces the General Fund costs of the resolve
15 by \$1,205 in fiscal year 1999-00.

17 As amended, this resolve includes an additional General Fund
18 appropriation of \$3,075 in fiscal year 1999-00 for the
19 Legislature for the per diem and expenses of legislative members
20 and the expenses of other eligible members of the Commission to
21 Propose an Alternative Process for Forensic Examinations for
22 Sexual Assault Victims and to print the required report.

26 **SUMMARY**

28 This amendment clarifies that, following the receipt of the
29 commission's report, the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal
30 Justice may report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of
31 the 119th Legislature. The amendment also strikes language that
32 entitles members other than Legislators to a per diem equal to
33 the legislative per diem.
