Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1015, sub-§10 is enacted to read:
10. Contributions by gubernatorial candidate. If a
candidate for Governor or the spouse of a candidate for Governor
loans or contributes an aggregate of at least \$25,000 to the
candidate's gubernatorial campaign, an opponent of the candidate
is not subject to the limitations on contributions required by
this section.
SUMMARY
This bill exempts a candidate for Governor from the
limitations on contributions if an opponent or spouse of an
opponent lends or contributes an aggregate of at least \$25,000 to
the opponent's gubernatorial campaign.
