The amounts are based on 4 36 nursing facilities participating with 12 consumers receiving care at \$49.45 per day per person. 38 The additional costs associated with adopting rules and 40 reporting to the Legislature can be absorbed by the Department of Human Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.' 42 44 **SUMMARY** 46 This amendment replaces the bill. It retains the emergency 48 nature of the bill and allows nursing facilities more than 30 miles from licensed assisted living facilities to provide

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assisted living level services for up to 6 persons. It requires
compliance with federal and state licensing requirements. It requires the Department of Human Services to report on its
experience providing care under this provision by April 1, 2000. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
