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This resolve includes additional General Fund appropriations of \$5,100 and \$3,050 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for the Legislature for the per diem and expenses of legislative members and the expenses of other eligible members of the Citizens' Advisory Committee to Secure the Future of Maine's Wildlife and Fish and to print the required report.

28 30 32 The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the committee during the interim between legislative sessions can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. If an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the committee requires staffing assistance during the legislative session, the Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services.

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The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to participate as a member of the advisory committee and to provide staffing assistance. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

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This resolve also includes base allocations of Other Special Revenue funds of \$500 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 for the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to provide necessary services to the advisory committee. Allowing the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to accept funds from any public or private source may result in an increase in dedicated revenues collected by the department. The amounts can not be determined at this time.

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### COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 725, L.D. 2045

The Department of Environmental Protection, the Department of Conservation and the State Planning Office will incur some minor additional costs to participate as members of the advisory committee. These costs can be absorbed within the agencies' existing budgeted resources.'

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#### SUMMARY

This amendment adds 2 additional members of the House of Representatives, 2 people representing large and small businesses involved in the forest products industry, a trapper and a fish and wildlife law enforcement officer to the membership of the Citizens' Advisory Committee to Secure the Future of Maine's Wildlife and Fish. The amendment also adds an appropriation section, allocation section and fiscal note to the bill.

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
