
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 725, L.D. 2045, "Resolve, to Establish the Citizens' Advisory Committee to Secure the Future of Maine's Wildlife and Fish"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in paragraph E in the 2nd to 4th lines (page 1, lines 22 to 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ". The President must consult with the Chairs of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife prior to appointing the members"

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in paragraph F in the 2nd to 4th lines (page 1, lines 27 to 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ". The Speaker must consult with the Chairs of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife prior to appointing the members"

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision that requires the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House to consult with the Chairs of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife prior to appointing legislative members of the Citizens' Advisory Committee to Secure the Future of Maine's Wildlife and Fish.
