HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1433, L.D. 2056, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Secession"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "~~§2171-C.~~" in subsection 2 in the last line (page 2, line 21 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "municipality." the following: 'The persons initiating the petition shall submit a written report at the public hearing that describes the impact of the proposed secession on property taxes in the municipality as well as in the secession territory.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a requirement to the bill that secession petitioners submit a written report to the public hearing on the secession proposal detailing the impact of the proposed secession on local property taxes.
