This amendment, which replaces the bill, prohibits the Department of Environmental Protection from denying a permit for reconstruction of a structure in an area designated a V-Zone after January 1, 1999, including structures destroyed by an ocean storm. The amendment does not change the department's standards for reconstruction activities in a V-Zone that was designated as such prior to January 1, 1999.
