34	'FISCAL NOTE
36	This bill may increase prosecutions for Class E crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties
38	are estimated to be \$82.48 per day per prisoner. These costs are not reimbursed by the State. The number of prosecutions that may
40	result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

44	The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
46	Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
