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## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 736, L.D. 2086

This bill also includes a General Fund appropriation of \$66,728 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to contract with an organization to administer the Maine Farms for the Future Program. The estimated General Fund appropriations required to fund the full year costs will be approximately \$70,356 annually beginning in fiscal year 2001-02.

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## SUMMARY

12 This amendment clarifies that the approval of Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources is needed 14 for a selected farm to receive more than \$5,000 for contracted services as part of a services package. It specifies that the 16 annual report by the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources on this program is made to the joint standing committee 18 having jurisdiction over agricultural matters. The amendment also adds an appropriation and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
