SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 738, L.D. 2088, Bill, "An Act to Revise Certain Provisions of the Fish and Wildlife Laws"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 20.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment removes the language that makes it illegal to trap bear with more than 2 traps at one time.
