
SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to S.P. 738, L.D. 2088, Bill, "An Act to Revise Certain Provisions of the Fish and Wildlife Laws"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 19.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provision of the bill that repealed the exemption for nonresidents who hold a valid Maine guide license from the requirement that nonresidents hunting bear with the use of dogs employ and hunt with a resident Maine guide.
