Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2074, sub-§3-B is enacted to read:

6 3-B. Fine doubled. The penalty for a violation of
8 subsection 1, paragraph A is twice the amount of the fine
10 designated in accordance with Title 4, section 164, subsection 12
12 for a speeding violation under section 2073 involving a similar
14 excessive rate of speed.

SUMMARY

14 This bill creates a fine for speeding in a school zone that
is double the fine for speeding outside of a school zone.
