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SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 741, L.D. 2100, Bill, "An Act to Allow Workers' Compensation Board Advocates to Prioritize and Decline Cases"

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Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

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'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, there are a substantial number of workers in this State who have been laid off from their jobs, who have pending workers' compensation claims and for whom resolving these claims as quickly as possible is critical; and

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Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'


