Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1.


Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment removes the reporting requirement and the associated minor additional costs that would be incurred by the Finance Authority of Maine.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that the Finance Authority of Maine provide a report of all contributions made to Maine College Savings Program accounts to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services for verification purposes to avoid a potential breach of confidentiality regarding information that is subject to verification by the taxpayer.
