	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5219-Q is enacted to read:
	§5219-Q. Maine College Savings Program credit
	A resident individual is allowed a credit against the tax
	otherwise due under this Part in the amount of 10% of the amount
	contributed to an account pursuant to the Maine College Savings
	Program, as established in Title 10, section 1013, subsection
	16. This credit is limited to a maximum of \$1,500 in any one
,	year. In no case may this credit reduce the Maine income tax to
	less than zero.
	SUMMARY
	This bill provides a 10% income tax credit for contributions
	to the Maine College Savings Program, up to a maximum credit of
	\$1,500.
