Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, chapter 201, subchapter VII, the Maine State Housing Authority shall transfer an additional \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 26 1999-00 and an additional \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 from 28 the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund to the Shelter Operating Subsidy program.' 30 FISCAL NOTE 32 This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriations in 34 the amount of \$2,000,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 and requires the Maine State Housing Authority to 36 transfer \$1,000,000 each year from the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund to the Shelter Operating Subsidy program. 38 **SUMMARY** 40 This amendment directs the Maine State Housing Authority to 42 transfer \$1,000,000 each year of the 2000-2001 biennium from the Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund to the Shelter Operating 44 Subsidy program.
