COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1471, L.D. 2111, Bill, "An Act to Implement Funding the Recommendations of the Interagency Task Force on Homelessness and Housing Opportunities in the November 1997 Task Force Report"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Table with 3 columns: Description, 1999-00, 2000-01. Includes MAINE STATE HOUSING AUTHORITY and Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund.

All Other \$2,000,000 \$2,000,000

Provides ongoing funding to expand the shelter operating subsidy program. Fifteen percent of these funds must be designated for shelter services to homeless youth and young adults.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1471, L.D. 2111

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund	\$2,000,000	\$2,000,000
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This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$2,000,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 for the Maine State Housing Authority to expand the shelter operating subsidy program.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. It provides first-year funding of \$2,000,000, adds 2nd-year funding and makes clear that this is intended to be ongoing funding. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
